PROGRAMS & IMPACT

GOALS was created to use the power of sport to engage youth with education and leadership opportunities to connect them to their community and environment. Through soccer, education and community service, GOALS is empowering youth to make positive change.

SOCCER

TEAM GOALS

Through the Team GOALS program, kids' natural love of soccer is leveraged to encourage the development of leadership skills, to promote inclusion and to strive for empowerment. GOALS has twelve youth soccer teams. The teams learn and play soccer plus through Purposeful Play games they learn social skills.

EDUCATION

LEVELLING THE PLAYING FIELD

Through Level the Playing Field activities, young people gain literacy and critical thinking skills while increasing their self-esteem and nurturing a new love of learning. We are increasing access to education for kids cutoff from traditional schooling.

HEALTH EDUCATION

The GOALS health education program provides training on the prevention and treatment of disease. Children receive teaching on hygiene and nutrition. Adolescent youth are taught sexual health education so they can make informed choices regarding their health, which has resulted in reduced teen pregnancy.

A CLEAN FIELD

Through our community gardens, tree nursery and recycling program youth gain a strong sense of community pride and learn activism. They are giving back through projects that improve the environment and produce much needed local food diversity. The program won the 2022 Energy Globe Award for our work to protect the environment.



YOUTH LEADERSHIP

The Youth Leadership program was designed in partnership with Georgetown University. It teaches important life and communication skills around leadership. Youth put the curriculum into practice by producing and managing community service projects.

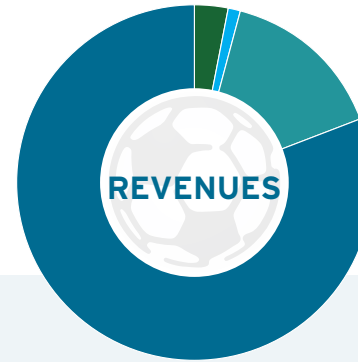
